Our appreciation this month is on Rev. Steve Wright. Steve is RTJ's Prison Director. Steve has been with RTJ for many years. Being the Prison Director involves many opportunities. I say opportunities instead of jobs because that is how Steve looks at it. Opportunities to serve the Lord in different areas but with the same coverage. Steve oversees all the bible studies and services at 6 prisons with a total number of 40 volunteers. Just at the Taylorville Prison Steve oversees 3 weekly bible studies and 2 regular church services. He makes sure all positions are covered, which many times he will do the services himself.

Steve has a very unique background being a former Prison Guard. One thing for sure if you work at the prison that you also have a bible study at. You walk your talk. We have another gentleman at the Vandalia Prison who is still a guard. His bible study is overwhelming.

I remember many years ago a chaplain that I greatly respect ask me to pray about having a DOC guard in our ministry. Let me tell you I told him real fast no. But I did agree to pray about it.

I went out on the compound of the prison and started asking inmates if Steve Wright had a bible study would you come? My response from these men was "There's not a day that goes by that Steve doesn't tell me how much our Lord loves us". My ill feeling concerning guards was seen in a new light. Not the old light of how I was treated years ago when I was in prison (which was much in my mind). But I saw Steve in a new light. Steve is very capable of actually running this whole ministry himself if need be. He is defiantly my Armor Bearer.
